The Ferrari F40, a sportcar produced by Ferrari, is the heir to the Ferrari 288 GTO Evoluzione, built between 1987 and 1992. This is one of the last examples produced.

Among other special features, the car was the first road car in Ferrari's history to be built with a variety of composite materials,[6] such as Kevlar for the chassis, fibreglass for the bodywork, aeronautical resins for the fuel tanks and Plexiglas for the side windows, and was, at the time of the presentation, the fastest road car ever built with a claimed 324 km/h.

It was the last Ferrari equipped with a turbocharged engine and built under the supervision of Enzo Ferrari.
